



## Expressions of Interest for Editor in Chief of Vox Sanguinis

The International Society for Blood Transfusion is seeking a new Editor-in-Chief for Vox Sanguinis, the flagship journal of ISBT. The new Editor is expected to commence the role on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 and will benefit from a 6-month period of overlap with the current Editor-in-Chief, before taking full responsibility for the journal on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Remuneration and administrative support will be in keeping with the typical arrangements for this type of editorial role.

### The Editor-in-Chief will:

- Develop and provide a vision of excellence for the Journal whilst building on its heritage.
- Provide leadership to the editorial team (section editors and publisher) with the aim to improve the international standing of the journal.
- Work with the section editors to maintain a high quality of peer review and communication with authors.
- Work with the section editors to ensure a rapid and efficient review and turnaround time of submitted papers.
- Act as an international ambassador for the journal.

### The ideal candidate will demonstrate:

- Experience and broad knowledge in the field of transfusion medicine;
  - as an editor, or
  - as a section editor or editorial board member of a peer reviewed scientific publication.
- A position of respect and an extensive track record in the field of transfusion including a track record of high impact publications.
- Time to commit to the required activities of the Editor- in- Chief position.

### Interested candidates are asked to submit a letter (2 – pages, A4) summarizing their expression of interest and including:

- Relevant experience.
- A vision for the future of Vox Sanguinis.
- An outline of leadership experiences that demonstrate your ability to interact effectively with teams you have led and with committees and boards on which you have served.
